Land Trust Certification Reminder

Land trusts that want to be certified by January 1, 2010 have only four full business days left to submit their Organizational Profile and fee of \$4,200 to the Division of Real Estate. This fee and Organizational Profile **must be received - not postmarked - by June 30, 2009.**

If your organization is missing any documents or cannot complete the Project List in time, you may submit the fee and the Organizational Profile now and then submit the missing information or documentation after June 30, 2009. This will allow a land trust some extra time to gather any necessary materials and still be considered for certification by January 1, 2010.

Please remember that beginning January 1, 2010, certification is statutorily required for any land trust to accept an easement for which a tax credit is claimed.
