Requires proficiency with GIS and GPS applications; experience in the field of land conservation; plant and noxious weed identification capabilities; knowledge of technologies for producing and archiving records; skilled in electronic communication and report production application; ability to communicate orally and in writing with solid proof reading skills; possess or obtain a valid Colorado Driver's license; and have an acceptable driving record.
